## DID YOU KNOW?

### IS THE STUDENT SPEAKERS FOUNDATION THE SAME AS THE STUDENT SPEAKERS CONTEST?

No, the Student Speakers Contest Committees /Chairs organize the contests at the various levels. The Foundation exists only to provide -college/university scholarships to the winners of the Districts, Areas, and MD-4 contests.

### WHAT ARE THE SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED?

The winners of the 15 District level contests each receive a \$4,500.00 scholarship. The winners of the 4 Area contests (District winners) each receive an additional \$6,500.00 scholarship, and the MD-4 winner receives an additional \$10,000.00 scholarship. Therefore the overall winner receives a total of \$21,000.00 in scholarships.

### HOW IS THE MONEY RAISED TO PROVIDE THE SCHOLARSHIPS?

Through tax deductible donations, gifts, bequests, Fellowships, and the Supporter Patch Program.
